SECURITY CONTRACT AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

BRIXTON SECURITY SERVICES LIMITED

AND

KENYA INDUSTRIAL TRAINING INSTITUTE (KITI)

CONTRACT NO: NKU/CTY/CC/30/2024-2026

CONTRACT PERIOD: 1ST MARCH 2025 – 30TH JUNE 2026

GUARDING SERVICES CONTRACT

This Agreement is made this 1ST day of MARCH, 2025 between **BRIXTON SECURITY SERVICES LIMITED**, a limited liability company duly incorporated in the Republic of Kenya under the Companies Act 215 Laws of Kenya (hereinafter referred to as “**the company**”) of P.O Box 48898 - 00100 Nairobi on one part and **KENYA INDUSTRIAL TRAINING INSTITUTE (KITI)** of P.O Box 280 – 20100 NAKURU (hereinafter referred to as (“**the client**”) on the other part.

WHEREAS:

- I. The company is a limited liability company carrying on the business of provision of security services.
- II. The client is desirous of engaging the Company for provision of the aforesaid guarding services at their premises at NAKURU.
- III. The Company is desirous of rendering the said services to the Client upon the terms and conditions stipulated herein.

THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Description of Services

The Company shall provide manned guarding and /or dog patrol services to the client as requested. Subject to the provisions of this Contract, the Company shall carry out such services with the due diligence and proper care.

2. Terms of Contract

This contract shall take effect on the date first written herein above and shall be valid for the period between 1st March 2025 – 30th June 2026 and may thereafter be renewable for a further term as may be agreeable between the parties unless otherwise terminated by either Party in accordance with Clause 11 below.

3. Security Services In Respect of Premises and Property.

The Company shall ensure that the guards and personnel deployed to guard the premises and property therein shall be well trained and uniformed. The Company shall further ensure that its guards and personnel engaged in the performance of the services under this Contract shall be supplied and well equipped with the requisite and appropriate security gadgets and protective gear and equipment as shall be permitted by the Government of Kenya in the course of properly and effectively carrying out their duties for the duration of this Contract.

until such circumstances shall have ceased and the Client shall not be liable to make any payment for such services in respect of the period of such suspension and sums already paid there under in respect of such period shall be credited to the period following the resumption of the said services **PROVIDED** that at any time during the period of such suspension either party may serve upon the other 15 days termination notice in writing and unless the said services have been resumed before the expiration of such notice the contract shall terminate in accordance with such notice.

7. Service Charges

a. In consideration of the Company providing security guarding services to the Client's various premises as mentioned in clause 3 above, the Client shall pay for the services provided as follows:-

- ❖ Six (6) Day guards @ Kshs. 22,000 per 12hrs shift per month.
- ❖ Eight (8) Night guards @ Kshs. 22,000 per 12hrs shift per month.

Total Charge inclusive of 16% VAT = Kshs. 308,000

THUS, TOTAL SUM = KSHS. 308,000 Per month.

- ❖ **The tender sum of this contract VAT inclusive shall thus total to ksh 308,000**
- ❖ The client to pay through a cheque by 25th of every month. The cheque to be addressed to Brixton security services Limited or deposit cash to the following company bank account:

- b. The Client may increase or decrease the number of guards /dog handlers and /or premises from time to time as shall be required and the terms of this contract shall apply to each and every personnel so deployed at any one time and at any one place.
- c. The service charges as set out above shall be paid to the Company promptly but in any event, not later than 25th day of the month that service is provided. **PROVIDED** that if the Client shall be in default of payment of such charges for a period of seven (7) Days after the due date the Company shall without prejudice to any remedy available to it be entitled to discontinue rendering any services under the contract until effective payment is made.

d. The client shall not withhold or defer payment of the service charge due to pending claims or counterclaims against the Company. Service charge payments and claims against the company shall be treated separately and independently and compensation shall only be considered once liability to the company is established beyond any reasonable doubt and in accordance with clause 5 of this contract.

e. Dishonored Cheques.

Any cheque issued by the Client that is dishonored by the bank shall be subject to a surcharge of Kshs. 3,500.00 or 5% of the amount involved, whichever is higher.

f. Revision of Service Charges.

The Company reserves the right to revise its rates of charge for providing the service under the contract:

- ❖ By notice if the reason is necessitated pursuant to an agreement with a Trade Union which for the time being represents the employees of the company.
- ❖ With notice if the revision arises from any action of the Government or of any local authority the effect of which is to raise the wages of the Company's employees. In such circumstances, the Company shall be entitled to back-date the revision of the rates to the date when the rise in wages became effective.

8. Engagement of other Security Firms

The Client shall not during the continuance of this contract engage any other firm or company to provide similar services to those contracted hereunder in respect of the same premises.

9. Complaints against Company OR Its employees

It shall be a condition precedent to any liability of the company hereunder that any complaint must be reported to the Company in writing of the occurrence of the incident which is subject to the complaint or alleged loss or injury, failing which no liability whatsoever on the part of the Company or its servants or agents shall arise.

10. Termination of Contract by the Company or Client

During the continuance of this agreement either party may terminate this agreement without assigning any reason thereto by giving one (1) calendar month's notice or, for the Client, pay one (1) month's charges in lieu thereof.

Either party shall have the right to terminate this agreement without notice if the other party being a Company shall go into liquidation either voluntarily or compulsory (save for reconstruction or amalgamation) or shall have a receiver appointed over the whole arrangement with its creditors or being a person shall become bankrupt or insolvent or enter into any arrangement with his /her/their creditors or takes or suffers any similar action in consequences of debt or is in breach of any of the terms of this contract.

11. Confidentially

The parties shall not disclose, divulge and /or disseminate to any third party confidential information on its security arrangements (including but not limited to the assignment instructions, schedule and other subsequent agreements) and/or business of the client. This obligation will not apply to information which is or becomes public knowledge through no fault of the parties or which the parties might be required to disclose under applicable law or by order of a competent judicial or Court authority.

12. Notices

All notices, demands and other communication required or desired to be given herein by any party shall be in writing and shall be deemed validly served on the other party for (4) days after posting or where delivered by the hand at the offices of the other party detailed below, at the time of delivery.

The Contract and these conditions constitute the entire agreement between the Company and the Client and no amendment, variation, waiver or modification of any terms or conditions hereof shall be effective unless in writing and signed by or on behalf of the parties. For avoidance of doubt, it is hereby declared that no person other than a Director or Secretary or

4. **Liability**

- a. The Company shall accept liability for any losses, injury or damages to persons or property, of whatever nature or however caused or for any act or default of the Company or its servants or agents **PROVIDED** that any loss or damage, cogently proved after thorough investigations to have been directly caused by the negligence or willful default of the Company or its employees in the performance of their duties, shall be referred to the Company's insurers for settlement in accordance with the terms of the Company's Insurance policy cover.

6. **Force Majeure**



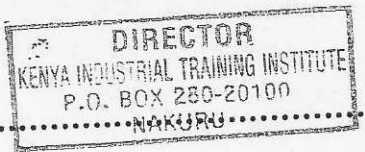
